- Covid Safety Kits discussed. Dan will work with Alvin, John to check inventory. Dan will look into future availability of testing source. L.H: Incident Command Center has masks available if needed. Discussed LLBO/IHS stats.
- School Director: Reading Achievement, Dan discussed data portfolio containing school-wide, class-by-class, student-by-student data. School-wide reading goal for SY21-22: By May 2022, 80% of students who were enrolled at the start of the school year and throughout the school year will meet their "expected Lexile growth" set within the Achieve 3000 program or complete their "personalized learning path" set within the Smarty Ants program. Current data shows growth in most grade levels. Struggling grades are being closely monitored.
